When I received the Protac 1AAA, I was not sure what to expect as I rarely carry a flashlight of this size and probably would not have bought this from a store. When I removed it from the packaging though, I was surprised at the durable feel and balance of the light in my hand. The tail switch operation was easy and had little to no learning curve to operate. Even the belt clip attached to the light felt well-built. I was even more impressed when I placed the single AAA battery in the housing and turned on the light. While the factory says the light is 70 lumens, I felt the light carried more power. All three settings: high, low and strobe, give off clean, white light. The battery life is very close to factory specs of over two hours on high (AAA lithium battery.) I have used the light on duty at crime scenes and even conducted some building clearing training with it. The only flaw I found comes from the nylon belt case it comes with. This had very little use to me as this light fits so well in my pants pocket. Since this light arrived, it has been with me everywhere from on duty to walking the dog at night. With a price point of under \$40 (from my online search), this light is a big value in a little package.

The ProTac 1AAA LED Flashlight outperformed my department-issued rechargeable flashlight. The size allowed for a comfortable, sleek fit in hand. The multi-function tail switch push-button was easy to use. The tail switch allowed for a full hand grasp while only having to utilize one finger to turn on the flash light. The flashlight was dropped, wet and weathered, yet still proved to be durable with no maintenance requirements. Its small size allowed for the convenience of carrying it in a shirt pocket or pant pocket. The pocket clip allowed one to clip it almost anywhere. I carried the flashlight clipped to the front of my uniform shirt in between the top buttons; the clip was sturdy and it secured the flashlight in place. The flashlight's output was brighter than my department-issued flashlight and provided an impressive beam for its size. I recommend the Pro Tac 1AAA as it is versatile, convenient and easy to use.
